Four additional vessel inspections were attempted, however the vessels were found to be unattended.

Beach Report

The Marco Island Police Department increased staffing during the Memorial Day weekend on the Island's beaches and waterways. This included utilizing Reserve/Auxiliary Police Officers as well as additional law enforcement and Community Service Officers. The Department increased public education efforts relative to beach expectations, to include utilizing a large electronic message board positioned on Hideaway Beach to dissuade individuals from bringing dogs onto Sand Dollar/Tigertail/Hideaway Beach areas. In response to its holiday initiatives, the Department received written commendations from the Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission Regional Biologist and Rookery/Audubon staff and volunteers.
