In March 2017, MIPD was made aware that Ford Motor Company had sent out a technical bulletin regarding exhaust leaks in some Explorer vehicles. **There was no recall.** We are also aware of reports of Officers in other states or jurisdictions becoming overcome by fumes, passing out and crashing.

Out of abundance of caution and in an effort to be proactive, we asked Executive Auto to work with Ford to learn as much as possible about the technical bulletin described. Executive Auto also tested a MIPD patrol vehicle with a carbon monoxide detector from the Marco Island Fire-Rescue Department. Results were negative.

Carbon monoxide sensors have been installed in the interior (rear) of Vehicles #162 - #168. If activated, MIPD Officers have been instructed to stop driving and notify their supervisor immediately. MIPD continues to monitor this issue.

Automated External Defibrillator "AED-Equipped" vehicle decals were recently affixed to all MIPD patrol vehicles. These decals notify the public that MIPD patrol vehicles are equipped with the life-saving AED devices.

June 1: Chief Schettino attended the graduation ceremony at Tommie Barfield Elementary School.

June 5 – 9: MIPD Officers educated students participating in the Marco Island Police & Fire Youth Academy (*see photo*).

June 12 – 16: MIPD Officers educated students participating in Camp Mackle Summer Camp (*see photo*).

June 15 – 16: Collier County Bureau of Emergency Services held hurricane preparedness classes for City of Marco Island employees at the MIPD Emergency Operations Center.

June 20: MIPD Officers educated students participating in the Leadership Marco Youth Program (*see photo*).

June 27: Chief Schettino, a member of the Collier County Community Assessment Committee, attended a planning meeting in collaboration with the Schulze Family Foundation regarding the upcoming Collier County Community Survey.

MIPD Officers continued the ongoing and multi-year program in June to provide bicycle lights and helmets to citizens in need. Helmets were donated by the Knights of Columbus. Bike light kits were donated by the Marco Police Foundation and Officer Bill Miller. MIPD Officers encountered six bicyclists in June. All six had proper working head/tail lights.
